



Mr. sc. Mira Zovko ima 20 godina iskustva u području zdravstvene ekologije i zaštite okoliša, s naglaskom na integralni pristup procjene opterećenja (emisija) na sastavnice okoliša, koji razmatra zdravstvene, socijalne i okolišne aspekte. Nakon rada u Zavodu za javno zdravstvo dr. Andrija Štampar, posljednjih je deset godina zaposlena u Hrvatskoj agenciji za okoliš i prirodu kao voditeljica Odjela za dokumente zaštite okoliša, gdje je najveći dio vremena posvećena poslovima obrade podataka, izradi procjena i pripremi podataka i informacija za izvješćivanje o stanju okoliša u Hrvatskoj. Od tema kojima se bavi, izdvajaju se tzv. integrirane teme: Okoliš i zdravlje, Turizam i okoliš, Promet i okoliš, Održiva proizvodnja i potrošnja, Kružno gospodarstvo i dr.

Izvršna je urednica i jedna od autora „Izvešća o stanju okoliša u Republici Hrvatskoj“ (<http://www.azo.hr/Izvjescia30>) te publikacija kojima se osigurava prikaz podataka javnosti (<http://www.azo.hr/Publikacije24>). Također surađuje s Europskom agencijom za okoliš i Ujedinjenim narodima na europskom (<http://www.eea.europa.eu/soer>) odnosno globalnom izvješću o stanju okoliša (<http://web.unep.org/geo/assessments/geo-6-process>). Rukovodi uspostavom i nadogradnjom dijela Informacijskog sustava zaštite okoliša RH u području tzv. općih tema zaštite okoliša (<http://iszo.azo.hr/>) s naglaskom na dokumente zaštite okoliša i održivog razvitka (strategije, planovi, programi i izvješća) i sustav upravljanja okolišem EMAS (Eco-Management and Audit Scheme). Kao članica nekoliko radnih skupina i povjerenstava pri Ministarstvu zaštite okoliša i energetike, Ministarstvu zdravstva, Ministarstvu turizma, Ministarstvu graditeljstva i prostornoga uređenja te pri Hrvatskom zavodu za javno zdravstvo i Institutu za turizam sudjeluje u provedbi projekata i izradi strateško-planskih dokumenata, izvještaja i zakonodavstva vezanog uz zaštitu okoliša i navedene sektore. Također je članica EIONET-a (Informacijske promatračke mreže Europske unije) kao Nacionalna kontakt točka Hrvatske za izvješćivanje o stanju okoliša te za temu Okoliš i zdravlje, kao i Odbora EMAS pri Europskoj komisiji. Od 2007. godine aktivna je u Tehničkom odboru 207 – Upravljanje okolišem Hrvatskog zavoda za norme te ima praksu u uvođenju sustava upravljanja okolišem u poslovanje organizacija. Autorica je tridesetak znanstvenih i stručnih radova te članica nekoliko udruženja i projektnih timova iz područja nutricionizma, biotehnologije, biologije i okoliša.

Mira Zovko, MSc has 20 years of experience in the field of public health and environmental issues, with an emphasis on the integrated environmental assessment due to sectorial pressures (emissions) on the environmental components, which considers the health, social and environmental aspects. After Andrija Stampar Teaching Institute of Public Health, Mrs. Zovko has for the past ten years worked in the Croatian Agency for the Environment and Nature as a Head of Environmental documents department. Most of the time she is dedicated to processing environmental data, making evaluation and preparation for reporting on the state of the environment in Croatia, with an emphasis on specific topics like Environment & Health, Tourism & Environment, Transport & Environment, Sustainable Production and Consumption and Circular Economy.

She is executive editor and one of the authors of the Croatian State of Environment Report (<http://www.azo.hr/lzvjesca30>) and publication which ensures the availability of environmental data to the public (<http://www.azo.hr/Publikacije24>). She cooperates with the European Environment Agency and the United Nations in drafting of the European State of the Environment Report (<http://www.eea.europa.eu/soer>) and Global Environment Outlook (<http://web.unep.org/geo/assessments/geo-6-process>). Mrs. Zovko leads a team that establishes and develops one part of the Croatian Environmental Information System (<http://iszo.azo.hr/>) – General environmental protection topics, with an emphasis on environmental and sustainable development documents (strategies, plans, programs and reports) and environmental management system EMAS (Eco-Management and Audit Scheme). As a member of several working groups and committees established by the Ministry of Environmental Protection and Energy, and some other ministries and institutions (eg. the Ministry of Health, Ministry of Tourism, Ministry of Construction and Physical Planning, Croatian Institute of Public Health, Institute for Tourism etc.), she cooperates in the implementation of projects and preparation of environmental and sectorial strategic and planning documents, reports and legislative. She is also a member of the EIONET (European Environment Information and Observation Network) as a National reporting centre for the State of the Environment Reporting and for the Environment & Health, established by the European Environment Agency. She is a member of the European Commission's EMAS Committee. Since 2007, Mrs. Zovko has been active in the Technical Committee 207 - Environmental Management, which operates at the Croatian Standards Institute. She is experienced in introducing environmental management systems in organizations. Mrs. Zovko is the author of thirty scientific papers and a member of several associations and project teams in the field of the nutrition, biotechnology, biology, environment and environmental reporting.
